Description

Many Mothers is a 501c(3) organization dedicated to supporting and strengthening families with newborn infants. Our mission is to provide in-home services and wraparound care to achieve health equity and wellbeing for babies and their caregivers in Northern New Mexico. Our long-standing Maternal Support Program provides practical, hands-on support to all families with newborns through home visits by trained volunteers.

Many Mothers also operates a Parenting Center for families with children from birth to three-years-old. In addition to classes, we provide food, clothing, safe sleep education and materials, and baby supplies such as diapers, wipes, formula, and baby equipment.

Job Description

Many Mothers seeks a board member with experience in human resources, finance, mental health, marketing, strategic planning, health care, or project management and a personal commitment to our Board values (compassion, understanding, equity, respect, competence, accountability, openness, and diversity).

- Annually approve the budget, making sure it is aligned with the MM mission and vision
- Demonstrate willingness to participate actively in fundraising and resource development activities
- Give a personally meaningful donation to ensure 100% board giving
- Prepare for and actively participate in Board meetings, training sessions, strategic planning discussions, committees, and MM events
- Review program and evaluation data on an ongoing basis
- Annually evaluate the performance and compensation of the Executive Director
