Time Commitment: Many Mothers can host an intern on a set schedule between 10-30 hours per week.

Background

Many Mothers' mission is to provide in-home services and wraparound care to achieve health equity and wellbeing for babies and their caregivers in Northern New Mexico.

Summary of Position

Many Mothers is seeking a highly skilled, values-aligned individual to join our growing team. The duties of the intern will focus on supporting the administrative and operating needs of the program as well as the Many Mothers Family Center. With training and guidance, the intern will be working directly with the public by assessing their needs and making relevant recommendations to staff. The Intern will also work Many Mothers' Maternal Mental Health Initiative conducting and/or assisting with non-clinical screenings related to postpartum depression.

Primary Roles and Responsibilities

- Serve as a point of contact for referrals or for walk-ins at the Family Center;
- Manage the Caregiver's Meetup at the Santa Fe Children's Museum. The responsibilities would include facilitation of the group, sending a weekly email, managing attendance, and ensuring the group upholds the mission and values of Many Mothers;
- Enroll families in different programs with guidance from staff;
- Willingness to attend trainings focused on postpartum depression and other maternal mental health disorders;
- Willingness to learn case management software;
- Participate in MM outreach events;
- Provide informed support to Many Mothers' Maternal Support Home Visiting Program
- Listen to families
- Participate in Staff meetings

Required Qualifications

- Working toward at least an associate's, bachelor's or advanced degree in Social Work, Psychology, Community Health Work, Human Services, or a closely related field;
- At least 6 months of creating and managing client intake and referral systems; or comparable training and activities
- Ability to manage multiple priorities at one time

Core Competencies

- High degree of integrity and dependability with a self-driven work style
- Demonstrated ability to set priorities
- Proven track record as an impactful negotiator, team player, and relationship builder
- Strong attention to detail
- Ability to prioritize competing tasks and projects
- Excellent communication skills (written and verbal)
- Willingness to address conflicts or issues as they arise
- Provides creativity, humility, humor, kindness, and flexibility
- Strong critical thinking skills, curiosity, and willingness to learn
- Commitment to developing and strengthening relationships with community members, peers, funders, and partners
- Solid understanding of child welfare and the 0-3 landscape.
- Some experience working with diverse communities; experience with New Mexico communities is helpful but not required
- Self-reflective approach to work and a willingness to offer and receive feedback in service of professional growth both individually and organizationally

Intern Outcomes and Opportunities

- Direct work with clientele within the aged 0-3 landscape, including infants, toddlers, pregnant and postpartum mothers, and their families
- Case management training
- Paid professional development and learning opportunities in the realm of infant and maternal health
- Ample opportunity to work with diverse populations of people
- Independent research development opportunities
- Technical training on case management software and other technical aspects of case management

Working Conditions

- Many Mothers encourages work flexibility to ensure a harmonious work-life balance
- Ability to work in-person at the Santa Fe Parenting Center in Santa Fe is required for this position (This is not a remote opportunity.)
- Work requires only minor physical exertion and/or physical strain.
